Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to all visitors and users of our website and mobile applications, and to anyone who interacts with us through these platforms.

2. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

3. USE OF INFORMATION

The information collected by Alt Mobility is used strictly for lawful business purposes, including but not limited to:

- Providing, maintaining, and improving our Services
- Facilitating vehicle delivery, servicing, insurance, and maintenance
- Sending operational updates, alerts, and renewal reminders

- All data is securely stored on servers located within India, unless otherwise required for specific integrations with adequate protection measures.

- Upon cessation of your relationship with Alt Mobility, you may request deletion of your personal information, subject to legal, regulatory, or contractual requirements.
